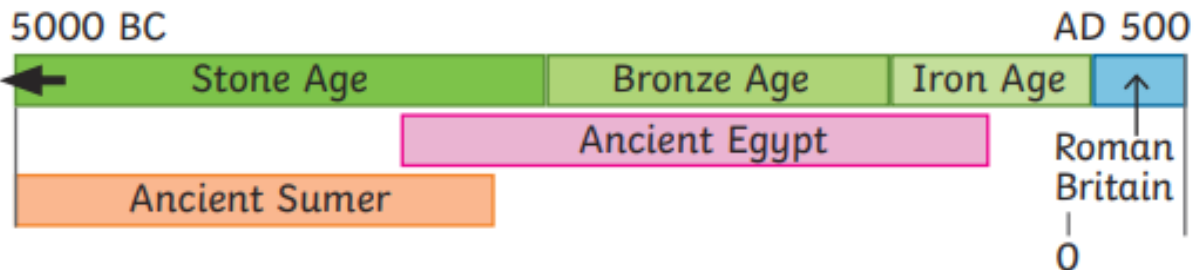

| <b>Stone Age</b>    | A time period when weapons and tools were made of stone or of natural materials such as bone, wood, or horn.   |
| <b>Pre-history</b>  | A time before any written records.   |
| <b>Palaeolithic</b> | The early phase of the Stone Age where primitive stone weapons and tools were used   |
| <b>Mesolithic</b>   | The middle phases of the Stone Age   |
| <b>Neolithic</b>    | The later part of the Stone Age where ground or polished weapons and tools were used.  |
| <b>Archaeology</b>  | Archaeology is the <b>scientific study of human life</b> by looking at artifacts, at the man-made objects that people who lived long ago have left behind. |
