The cross is the main symbol of Christianity. It reminds Christians that Jesus died on the cross to save them. The bread and wine represent the body and blood of Christ. Candles, lamps, light and flames represent the presence of God as the Light of the World. When someone dies a candle is sometimes lit to remember them. The fish is a symbol of Christian faith The Easter Story: Jesus was crucified on the cross but he rose again, so Christians believe the cross symbolises both God's sacrifice and the good news of his victory over death.
