English:

Key skills:

This half term we will study the famous author: Roald Dahl through these genres.

Maths:

In science we will learn how living things change over time. We will start by looking at a humans life cycle as well as the lifecycle of a chicken, butterfly and frog. We will also learn how to match offspring to their parent.
