## Animals



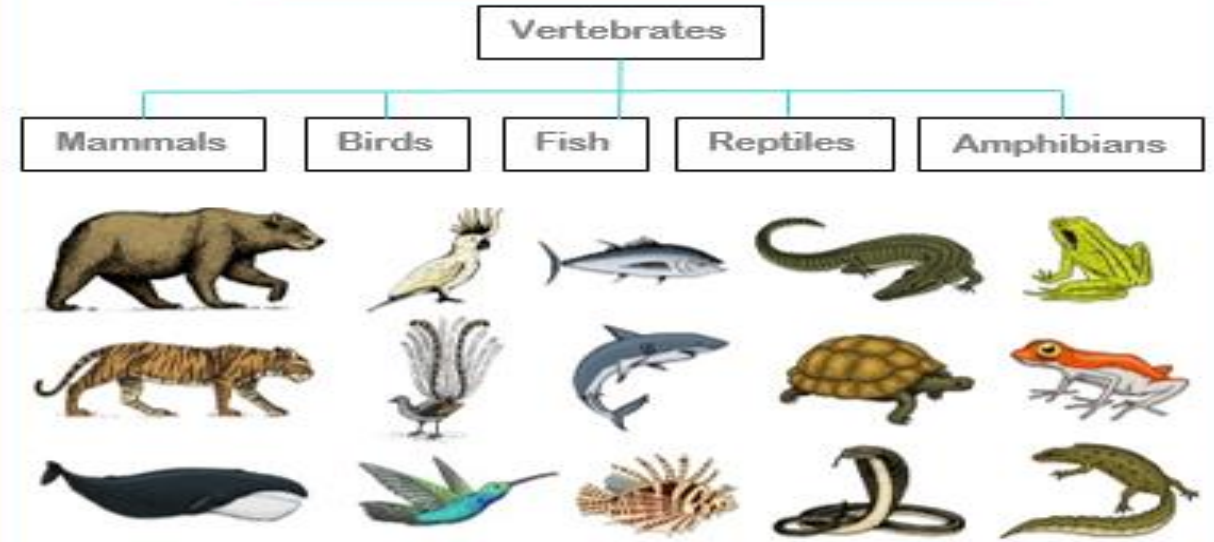
### STICKY KNOWLEDGE

There are 5 main animal groups, fish, amphibians, birds, reptiles, mammals.	Mammals are covered in fur or hair, give birth to live young. Birds have feathers covering their body and lay eggs.	Amphibians live on land and in water. Reptiles have scales and lay eggs of land. Fish have fins and breath through gills .
Omnivores eat meat and plants/ Carnivores eat just meat/ Herbivores eat just plants.	Wild animals live in the natural environment. Pets live with humans.	

### KEY VOCABULARY

Amphibian	A cold-blooded animal that spends some time on land and in water.
Reptile	Reptiles have a dry scaly skin and typically laying soft-shelled eggs on land.
Bird	A bird is a warm-blooded egg-laying animal that has feathers, wings, a beak, and typically they can fly.
Fish	A fish has gills, fins and lives in water
Mammal	Mammals are warm-blooded animals that have hair or fur.
