Our 'Stunning Start' to launch our topic will be:

A captivating and immersive evacuation story through the audio resource Now Press Play which engages the children through sound, story and movement.

We will enhance children's learning and 'Cultural Capital' with the following experiences, websites and texts:

- A range of inviting role play experiences
- Artefacts for children to observe and explore
- Trip to a World War Two experience at the Imperial War Museum

Our 'Showstopper' piece of work at the end of the topic will be:

• Class History Article
The children will showcase what they
have learnt about WW2 in a class
history article.

Our 'Shared Outcome'

The children will share their class article with the other classes within the year group.





Here is a breakdown of the skills and knowledge to be covered in each subject through this topic:

English:

Key texts: 'Goodnight Mister Tom'

Key skills:

- non-chronological reports
- Diary entries
- Flashbacks
- Blitz Poetry

Maths: key topics:

- Place Value
- Addition and subtraction
- Multiplication and division
- Fractions
- Converting units

We will end the half term on a SATs practise paper to consolidate our learning from the term.

<u>Suggested trips/places to visit:</u>

- Your local area/park
- The science museum

<u>Science:</u> Children will learn about evolution and inheritance. Focusing on how animals and plants have adapted over time to survive.

<u>History</u>: In history we will be looking at Britain on the home front during World War Two and what life was like for a variety of different people.

RE: Children will studying the religion of Buddhism.

<u>Art:</u> Children will be learning about famous animators and creating their own illustrations based on their styles.

PE: Children will learn Netball and Health Related Exercise – this will focus on the understanding of how to keep their bodies healthy and fit

<u>Music:</u> Pop music focused around songs with a Soul influence. The main song will be Happy by Pharrell Williams.

<u>Computing:</u> 3D lettering. How can I create a code for 3D lettering.

PSHE: Children will be learning about the Jigsaw piece 'Being Me in My World'. They will learn about what it means to belong, how it feels to achieve and about choices and consequences.
