<p>Foundation Curriculum—Arts Focus</p> <p>To further develop art across the curriculum by up skilling teachers and putting a greater emphasis on teaching skills/ high quality pieces of Art.</p> <p>(MUSIC<-ART-PLAN)</p>	<p>Reading</p> <p>To continue to ensure that every pupil at PW develops a love for reading and has success in this area.</p> <p>(ENGLISH PLAN)</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>To support children to apply their maths knowledge to reasoning by developing a mastery curriculum and embedding White Rose.</p> <p>(Maths Plan)</p>
<p>Writing</p> <p>To support more children to meet the expected level of writing across the school by explicitly teaching SPAG and allowing greater time for independent writing.</p>	<p>Oracy– Stage 2</p> <p>Continue to embed Oracy across the school. To ensure there is a clear progression of skills across the school and clear oracy outcomes.</p> <p>ORACY PLAN)</p>	<p>Pedagogy/ Assessment</p> <p>To ensure that teachers have a range of pedagogies that they can draw upon to teach high quality lessons.</p> <p>To ensure assessment is used as an integral part of lessons to assess where pupils are.</p>

Behaviour and Attitudes

<p>Behaviour</p> <p>To introduce a new behaviour strategy drawing with the PW values at it's core. To introduce mediation and self-regulation so pupils are in charge of their emotions.</p>
<p>Mental Health</p> <p>To introduce the Zones of Regulation to each classroom and use them as a tool for children to self-regulate their emotions.</p> <p>To introduce 'well-being' time into our week for pupils.</p>

Children and staff are supported and learning and teaching is exceptional across the school.

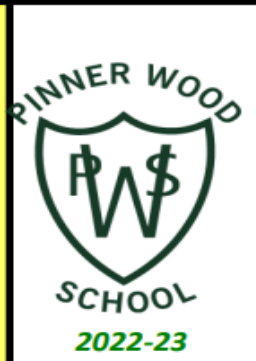
Personal Development
